BUILDINGS – IMPRESSIVE ARCHITECTURE

Hotel Koldingfjord is located in the heart of the most beautiful countryside, right next to Kolding Fjord and surrounded by 28 hectares of protected woodland. The impressive buildings were originally constructed in the period 1907-1911 to house the first “Christmas Seal Sanatorium” in Denmark. Postmaster Einar Holbøll started selling Christmas seals as early as 1904. From the time construction was complete and for the next 50 years, the buildings were used as a sanatorium for children suffering from tuberculosis. As such, the facility played an important role in the battle against this terrible illness.

Today, all the buildings have been carefully restored, and the classical external architecture is complemented by interior decoration in timeless Danish Design. Hotel Koldingfjord is now recognised as being one of the leading hotels and conference venues in Denmark. And many of our guests come back time and time again.

Travelling to Hotel Koldingfjord

Hotel Koldingfjord is centrally located in Denmark, but is nevertheless tucked away in a quiet spot – just 6 km from the E45 and E20 motorways, and 5 km from the centre of Kolding. There are also direct bus connections from the railway station to the Danish Museum for Nursing History, which is right next door to Hotel Koldingfjord. The location close to the biggest motorway “crossroads” in Denmark and the delightful situation next to Kolding Fjord make Hotel Koldingfjord the perfect place to meet. By car, Copenhagen is just 2,5 hours away and Hamburg no more than 3 hours, while Billund International Airport is an easy 45-minute drive from the hotel.

From Århus/Odense/Flensborg:

Take motorway exit no. 62 (Kolding Ø). At the roundabout, turn towards Kolding Havn (the harbour). At the second set of traffic lights – by the OK petrol station – turn left onto Lyshøj Allé. Then follow the signs to Hotel Koldingfjord.
